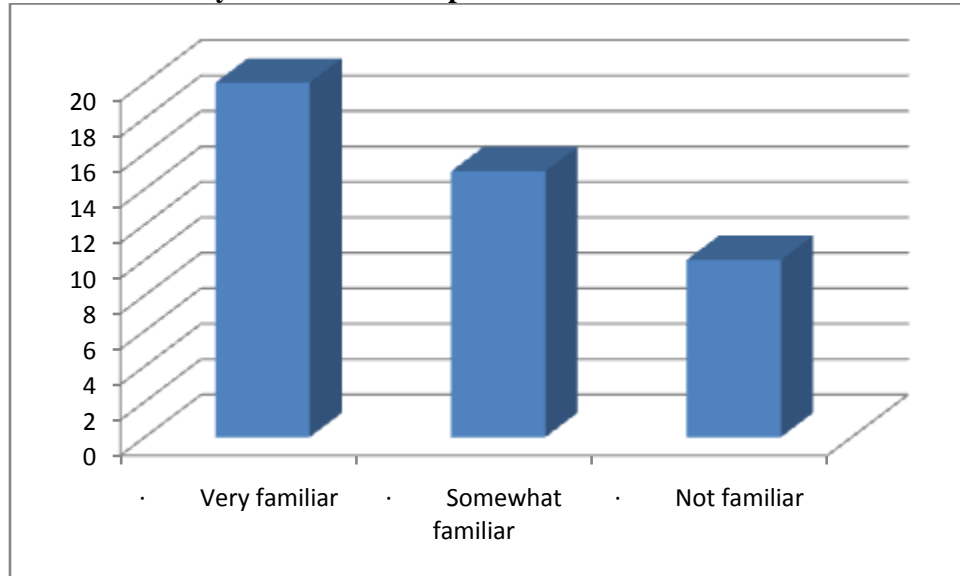

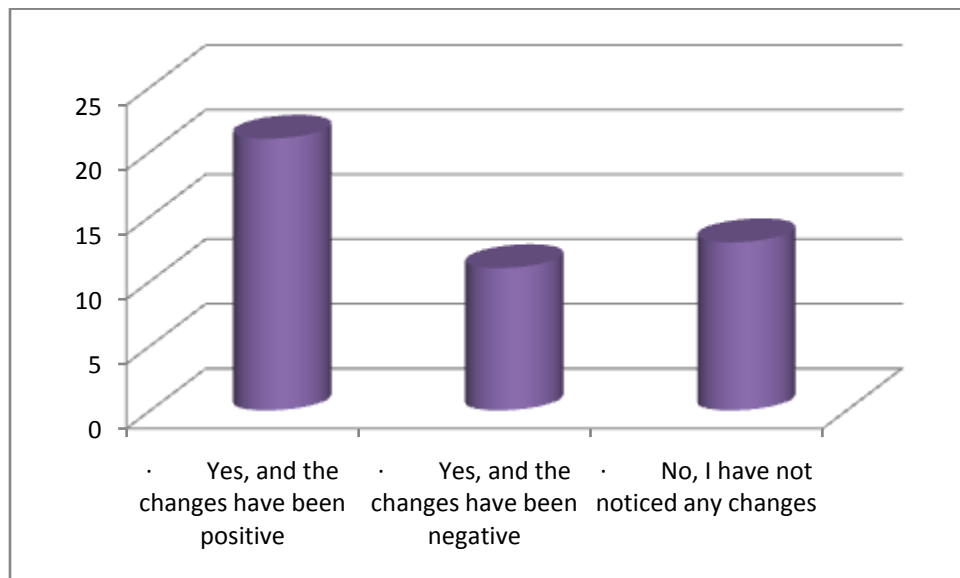
DATA ANALYSIS

1. How familiar are you with the concept of sustainable tourism in Arunachal Pradesh?



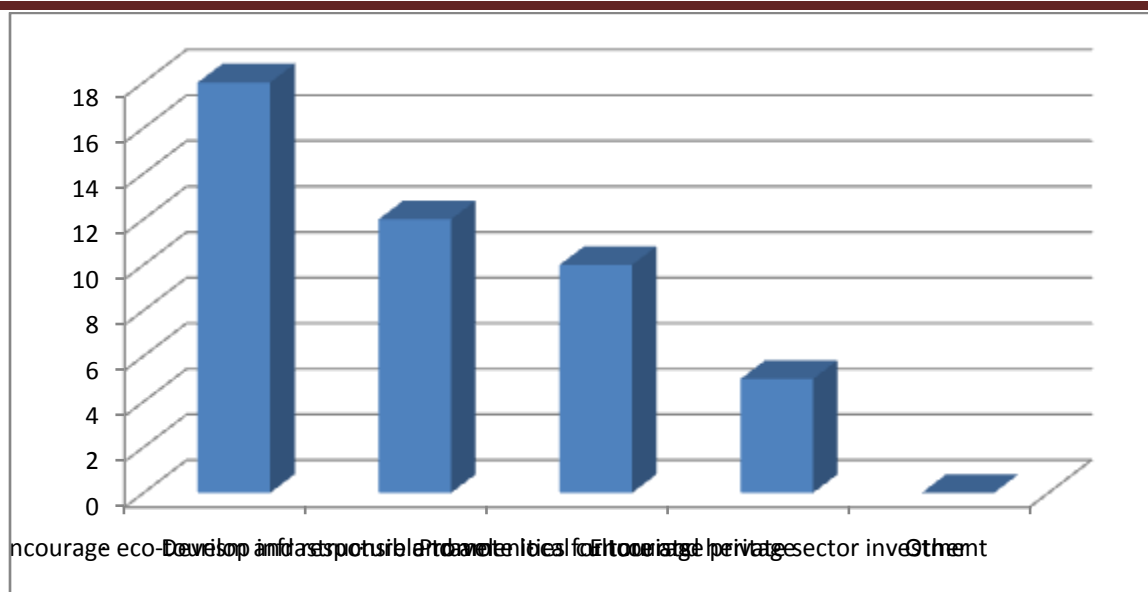
Most of the respondents were very familiar with sustainable tourism.

2. Have you noticed sustainable growth in the tourism industry in Arunachal Pradesh in recent years?



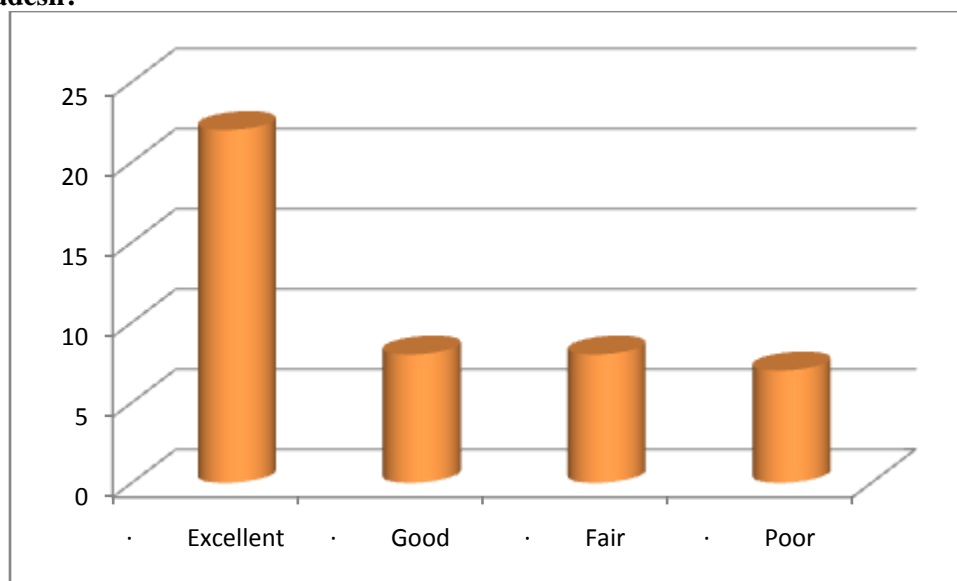
Most of the respondents have noticed positive and sustainable growth in the tourism industry in Arunachal Pradesh.

3. What steps do you think should be taken to ensure the sustainability of the tourism industry in Arunachal Pradesh?



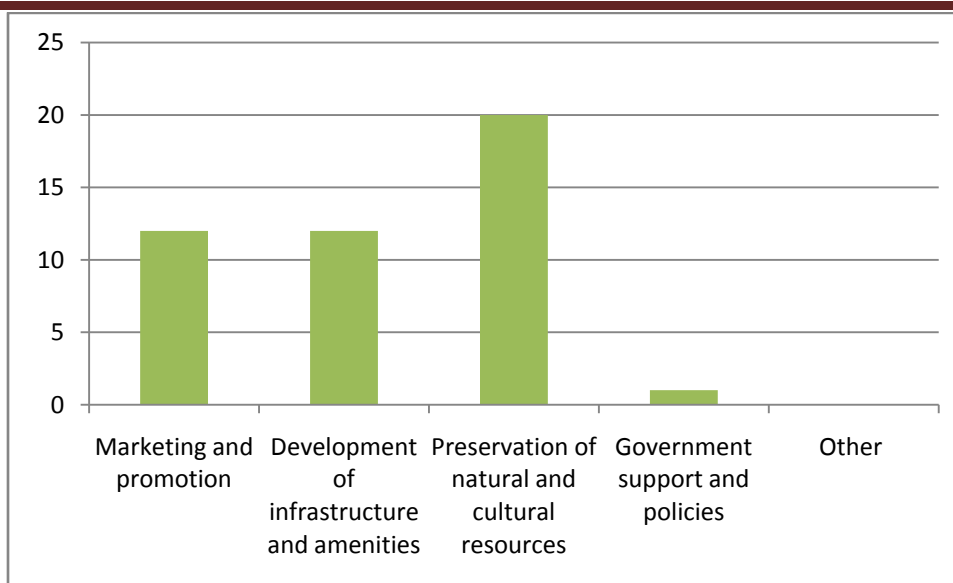
Most of the respondents think that encouragement of eco-tourism and responsible travel along with developed infrastructure and amenities are important for tourism.

5. What do you think is the most important factor for the growth of the tourism industry in Arunachal Pradesh?

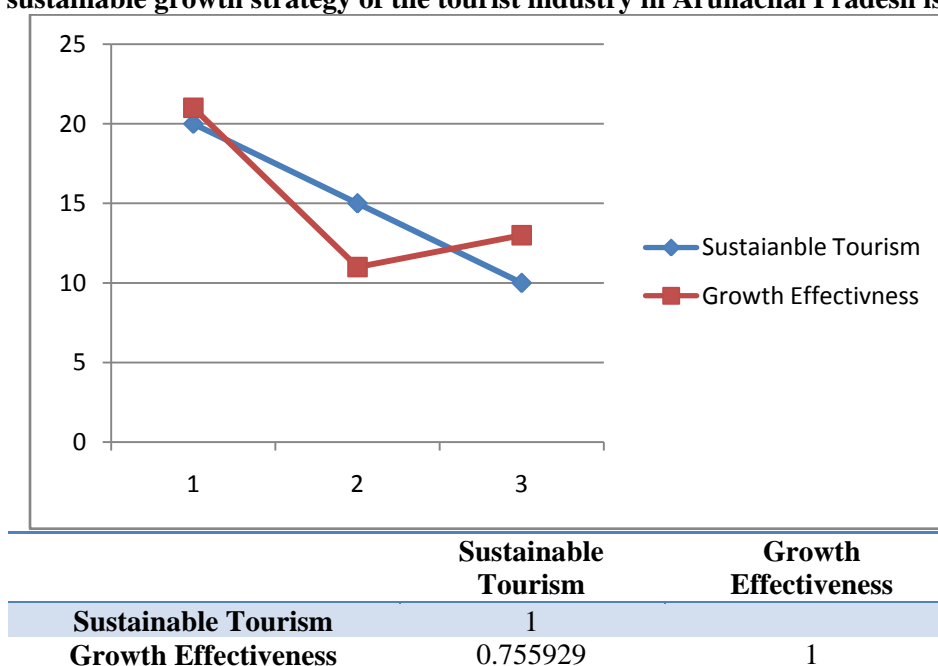


Preservation of natural and cultural resources is most important factor for the growth of the tourism industry in Arunachal Pradesh
